ARRIVAL/ DEPARTURE CARDS

1.0 GENERAL

Department of Immigration and Emigration has informed that they have simplified and amended the arrival/departure card of the Maldives. The Department is now issuing stocks of the new card free of charge to all airlines operating international flights to/from the Maldives.

A specimen of the new card is enclosed herewith for information.

2.0 PURPOSE

2.1 The purpose of this Circular is to advise all airlines that Department of Immigration and Emigration will accept only the new arrival/departure card effective 01st April 2010.

3.0 REQUIRMENT

3.1 Department of Immigration and Emigration has rescinded the requirement for airlines to print their own card stock. Stocks of new card are available free of charge from the Department of Immigration and Emigration – Airport Office.

3.2 Airlines operating international flights to/from the Maldives are urged to obtain the new arrival/departure card and discontinue disseminating the old card at the earliest possible.

3.3 Airlines operating international flights to/from Maldives are advised to ensure arrival/departure cards are disseminated to the disembarking passengers prior to landing and inform passengers to complete the card for submission on arrival.

4.0 APPLICABILITY

4.1 This Circular supersedes Air Transport Circular No. 69-CA-C/CIR/98/03 dated 10 September 1998.

4.2 The requirements in this Circular apply to all airlines operating international flights operating to the Maldives and the Airline Representatives.

4. Staying in Maldives without a valid permit is an offence.

This card should be completed and given to the Immigration officer at the time of arrival departure card must be retained in the passport for presentation to the Immigration officer at the time of departure.
