AIR SAFETY CIRCULAR

DRAFT ASC 66-1

Validation of Foreign Licences of Aircraft Maintenance Engineers

Initial Issue, 22 March 2011

1. REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

Compliance with this Circular is mandatory for local maintenance organisations approved under MCAR-145 and MCAR-M Subpart-F.

2. RELATED REGULATIONS

This Circular relates specifically to MCAR-66, MCAR-145 and MCAR-M.

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Circular is to establish the requirements for validation of foreign aircraft maintenance engineer (AME) licenses, issued by a Contracting State of ICAO.

4. GENERAL REQUIRMENTS

- (a) The request for validation of a foreign AME licence will be considered only from Maldivian Operators when adequate numbers of such qualified personnel are not available in the country. Operator shall furnish plans of training Maldivian AMEs and due justification for employing foreign personnel. Operators shall also clearly indicate their plans for phasing out the foreign AMEs.
- (b) Ratings are only issued for aircraft types on the Maldivian register.
- (c) The FAA A&P Certificate, or other ICAO state Certificates based on the FAA Certificate, are not recognised.

5. LICENCE AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

- (a) Applicants shall meet the licence and experience requirements set in Appendix IV to MCAR-145.30 (j).
- (b) Applicants must be able to reach an overall band score of at least 6.5 in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) General.

6. EFFECTIVITY

This Circular becomes effective on 01 September 2011.
